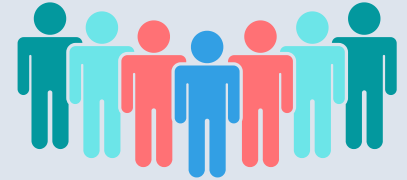

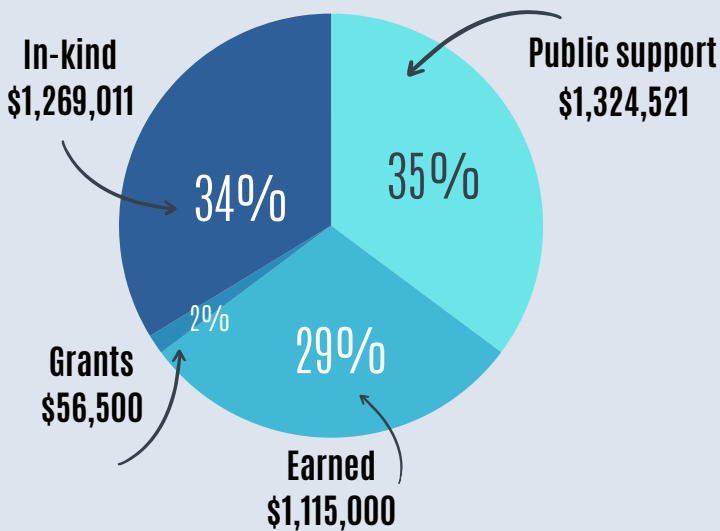

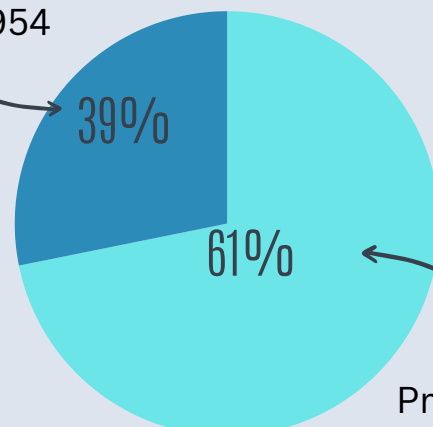
### Cash Revenue + In-kind
